## WHAT IS COPE?

COPE – our **C**ommittee **O**n **P**olitical Education – is the political action committee for AFT Washington. COPE:

- provides information to assist our members in understanding and engaging with the political process,
- asks and learns about what values and issues our members want to see our union prioritize in the political arena,
- raises political money from our membership through voluntary contributions,
- decides which candidates and ballot measures deserve AFT Washington's endorsement and financial support.

AFT Washington's membership deserves effective representation in government. We need to elect candidates who will stand up for public education and economic issues of concern to our members and other working families.

COPE enables our union to engage the membership in both crafting our political agenda and in making meaningful financial contributions to support candidates who will champion our agenda.



AFT Washington's COPE account is based only on voluntary member contributions. Our COPE account is only as plentiful and powerful as the amount of money that our members donate to it. For our union to play the strongest possible role in the political sphere, we're asking you to become a donor to COPE.

COPE is guided by an inclusive, memberbased, democratic process. The chair of this committee is elected every two years at our Federation's convention, and the voting members of COPE are appointed by the AFT Washington president and approved by the AFT Washington Executive Board from among the member donors. As a donor to COPE, you have the opportunity to give meaningful input to our COPE decision-making process. AFT Washington's COPE meets approximately once every two months.
