

THE FACTS about the FREEDOM FOUNDATION "Freedom" to hurt working people?

The Freedom Foundation (FF) is an anti-union group that has contacted AFT Washington members asking them to leave the union and become "fee payers." They claim workers will "get a raise" by opting out of the union. They claim they're for "freedom." Freedom from what? Freedom to have lower wages? Freedom to work without a contract that protects your rights? Freedom to take away your voice?

We're not falling for it. Here's the truth:

- Union workers make on average 13 percent more than non-union workers.
- African-American union members earn 31 percent more than their nonunion counterparts.
- The wage gap between women and men in nonunion workplaces is shameful. For nonunion workers, women earn only 78 cents for every dollar a man makes. But in union workplaces, women make 91 cents for every man's dollar, and the gap continues to close.

What is the Freedom Foundation?

The Freedom Foundation, an organization founded by the billionaire Koch brothers, is tiny, rich, and loud. The Koch brothers and their cronies make huge profits off low-wage labor. They use that money to prop up politicians – from local school boards to the U.S. Congress – who pass legislation that hurts us.

The real mission of the "Freedom" Foundation:

- To keep workers trapped in low wages.
- To break the unions and make America a pool of low-wage labor without the protections of a contract.
- To attack public sector workers that's us as the last barrier to the greed-based business plans of the 1 percent.

Here's what else the Freedom Foundation really stands for -

Attacks on working people: The foundation opposes an increase in the minimum wage, paid sick days, and increases in education funding.

Attacks on women and families: The foundation criticizes the rights of working women. FF CEO Tom McCabe declared there's a "concerted effort by liberals and women's groups to eradicate all manly jobs."(Just for the record, we are pro-jobs, "manly," "womanly" and "other.")

Attacks on LGBT rights: It said the Supreme Court ruling that legalized same-sex marriage, is a "threat to personal freedom" and it shares financial ties with groups who support "gay conversion" therapy. Attacks on environmental protections: It filed a lawsuit to block policies that would combat climate change.
